Mighty Mites--Kindergarten

Mondays and Wednesdays 1:00pm - 1:45pm

Spring Session:\$200/full session \$110/half session (11 week session runs 3/28 - 6/8)

A special class for ages 4-6, this class utilizes Quickstart Tennis to introduce FUNDamental technique, and combines hand-eye coordination exercises with rally games and court movement.

Mighty Mites

Mondays and Wednesdays 3:15pm - 4:00pm

Spring Session:\$200/full session \$110/half session (11 week session runs 3/28 - 6/8)

For ages 5-8, this class uses Quickstart Tennis to combine instruction on basic fundamentals and hand-eye coordination exercises with fun activities and games.

Future Stars

Mondays and Wednesdays 5:00pm - 6:00pm

Spring Session: \$240/full \$130/half session (11 week session runs 3/28 - 6/8)

8ids age 9 and older, who are beginners or have had some previous instruction will learn better fundamentals, scoring, and become more consistent through drills and games.

Junior Champs

Tuesdays and Thursdays 4:30pm - 5:30pm

Spring Session:\$240/full \$130/half session (11 week session runs 3/29 - 6/9)

Juniors who are developing consistency, power, and competitive instincts will get more playing experience, more advanced drills, and introductions to spins and strategy in this class.

Tournament Prep

Tuesdays and Thursdays 5:30pm - 6:30pm

Spring Session:\$240/full \$130/half session (11 week session runs 3/29 - 6/9)

Middle school players and players with JV high school experience will participate in this class, geared toward enhancing the skills needed to play at the varsity high school level. Focus will be on placement, spins, serving and strategy.

High School Varsity

Tuesdays and Thursdays 3:30pm - 4:30pm

Spring Session:\$85/full \$50/half session (4 week session runs 5/17 - 6/9)

(begins after HS districts)

Players that have finished with their varsity or JV high school season can get a head start on summer competition by taking this mini-session that will work on breaking bad habits and encouraging new, better ones.
