

Mighty Mites-Kindergarten

Tuesdays and Thursdays 2:15pm - 3:00pm

For ages 4-6, this class utilizes Quickstart on a 36' court to introduce fundamental technique and combines hand-eye coordination exercises with rally games and court movement.

Mighty Mites

Tuesdays and Thursdays 3:30pm - 4:15pm

This class meets later, is open to kids 5-8, and uses Quickstart tennis on a 36' court to develop rally skills, court movement, and hand-eye coordination.

Future Stars

Mondays and Wednesdays 3:15pm - 4:15pm

Kids age 9 and older, who are beginners or have had some previous instruction will learn better fundamentals, scoring, and become more consistent through drills and games.

Junior Champs

Mondays and Wednesdays 4:15pm - 5:15pm

Juniors who are developing consistency, power, and competitive instincts will get more playing experience, more advanced drills, and introductions to spins and strategy in this class.

Ages 10 - 14.

Tournament Prep

Tuesdays and Thursdays 5:15pm - 6:15pm

Intermediate to advanced middle school players will participate in this class, geared toward enhancing the skills needed to play at the varsity high school level. Focus will be on placement, spins, serving and strategy.

Tennis 101

Wednesdays 5:15pm-6:15pm and Fridays 4:15pm - 5:15pm

High school players who have little experience and are just starting to learn the game will find what they need in this group--learning skills and building confidence among their peers. The goal will be to try to get all of these players qualified to play JV tennis for the high school teams.

High School I (JV)

Tuesdays and Thursdays 4:15pm-5:15pm

Incoming freshman players and JV players from the previous high school season will work on strategic, technical, and conditioning aspects that will push their games toward the varsity level.

High School II (Varsity)

Tuesdays and Thursdays 4:15pm - 5:15pm

High school players with previous starting experience in singles or doubles will gain strength in all strokes through drills, games, and competition. Focus is on strategy and competitive skills, including physical conditioning and mental toughness.

- Any player wishing to move to a more advanced class must pass the TTC Junior Development Skills Test for their current class. Tests are administered once per session in class or can be arranged privately with Hunter or Colby for a \$12 fee.
