Format:

The list of regular players is in alphabetical order, and that's how we'll start the league. This coming Thursday, we'll assemble in the lobby and I'll get us kicked off for the season. The first four names on the list will play on court 1, the second four will play on court 2, the third foursome on court 3. Each player will play one set with each other player on his court, totaling 3 sets for the night (with no-ad scoring). I will have a scoresheet on the door to my office; fill in the total number of games you (or the person you're subbing for) won that night. Maximum games per night is 18, 12 if you are a sub. We'll move the top scores up a court and the bottom scores down a court to create new foursomes for the next week. The player with the

highest total number of games won at the end of the league period will be crowned the winner.

A few notes:

- Please make it on time so we don't carry over too late.
- The club will provide balls for this inaugural league.
- Colby or I will be on hand to make sure things get off to a smooth start each week. Subs. I'll also remind everyone that you are responsible for finding your own sub. I can't stress this enough, as an absent player will leave their three courtmates in a tough spot for the night. If you know you are going to be gone on a given week, work out the sub well in advance, and remind them prior to that night. All of the subs on the list should be in the directory, and everyone on the list has email.
